

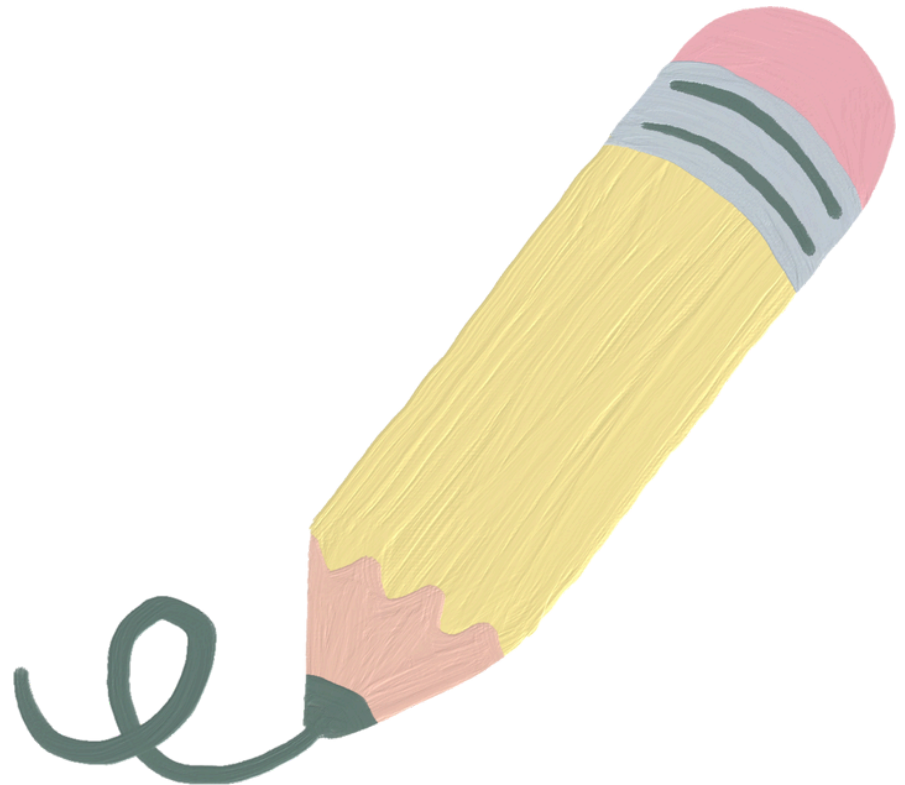

What is Climate Justice?
